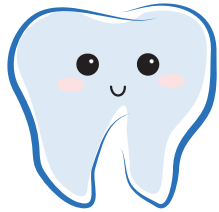


Would you be interested in a cavity prevention program visiting your school in Nashua?



A healthy smile is an important part of your child's health. Healthy teeth and gums play a key role in nutrition and eating, speaking and communicating, avoiding pain and discomfort, and supporting your child's confidence and mental health.

During the 2024-2025 school year, a cavity prevention program would provide students in grades K-12



- Oral health screenings
- Fluoride varnish to harden teeth and prevent decay
- Guided tooth-brushing instruction
- Oral health education and free dental care products

If needed, the cavity prevention program would provide treatment to strengthen and protect teeth, such as:

- Silver diamine fluoride to kill cavity causing bacteria
- Glass ionomer to seal the teeth
- Fluoride varnish to harden the teeth

For your child to receive services, you would be required to complete a consent form prior to the appointment.

Benefits of enrolling your child in a cavity prevention program:

Appointments take approximately 15-20 minutes, during school hours, up to two times a year.
